POOL RULES

1. Key must be accompanied by tag with property owners name on it.
2. Anyone found lending their pool key WILL lose his/her right to pool usage.
3. Anyone using the pool must park in designated area.
4. Do not drive thru other property owners lots to get to pool area.
5. Children must be under adult supervision. (Adult must be present)
6. All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. (Adult being 21 years of age)
7. Any person using the pool facilities do so at their own risk.
8. No running, horseplay, fighting, or any other dangerous conduct, or any conduct that would disturb others in the pool area will NOT be tolerated.
9. Towels must be placed over pool furniture when using suntan oils and lotions.
10. Absolutely NO glass containers are allowed inside pool area.
11. No food is allowed inside pool area.
12. Absolutely NO pets allowing inside pool area.
13. Safety equipment is to be used in case of emergency only.
14. Proper attire is to be worn when swimming. (No cut offs)
15. Any person who, in the sole judgement of a property owner, is under the excessive influence of alcoholic beverages will be excluded from pool area.
16. Smoking is allowed only in designated areas. (Within the red line)
17. Quite hours are from 10pm-8am. Anything considered a nuisance to the peace and solitude of others will not be tolerated.
18. Please help keep the pool area clean. (Pick up and place all trash in garbage can before leaving)
19. YOU, as a property owner, have the right to intervene and correct anyone violating the pool rules.

Violation of any of these rules will result in termination of the key privilages of the property owner.

Pavilion Rules (The Point)

1. No camping or campfires will be allowed on or around the pavilion area.
2. Anyone using the area should clean up and empty their garbage when leaving.
3. Do not throw rocks, trash, or any other debris into the lake area.
4. Pavilion is to be used by property owners only. Anyone found in the area that is not a property owner will be asked to leave.
